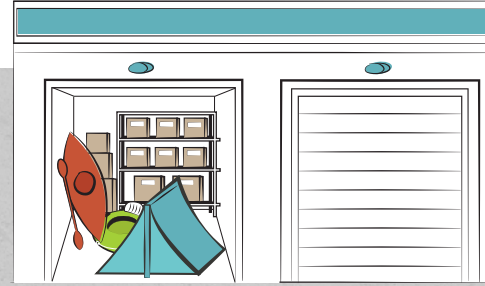


Have You Considered These Self-Storage Solutions?
