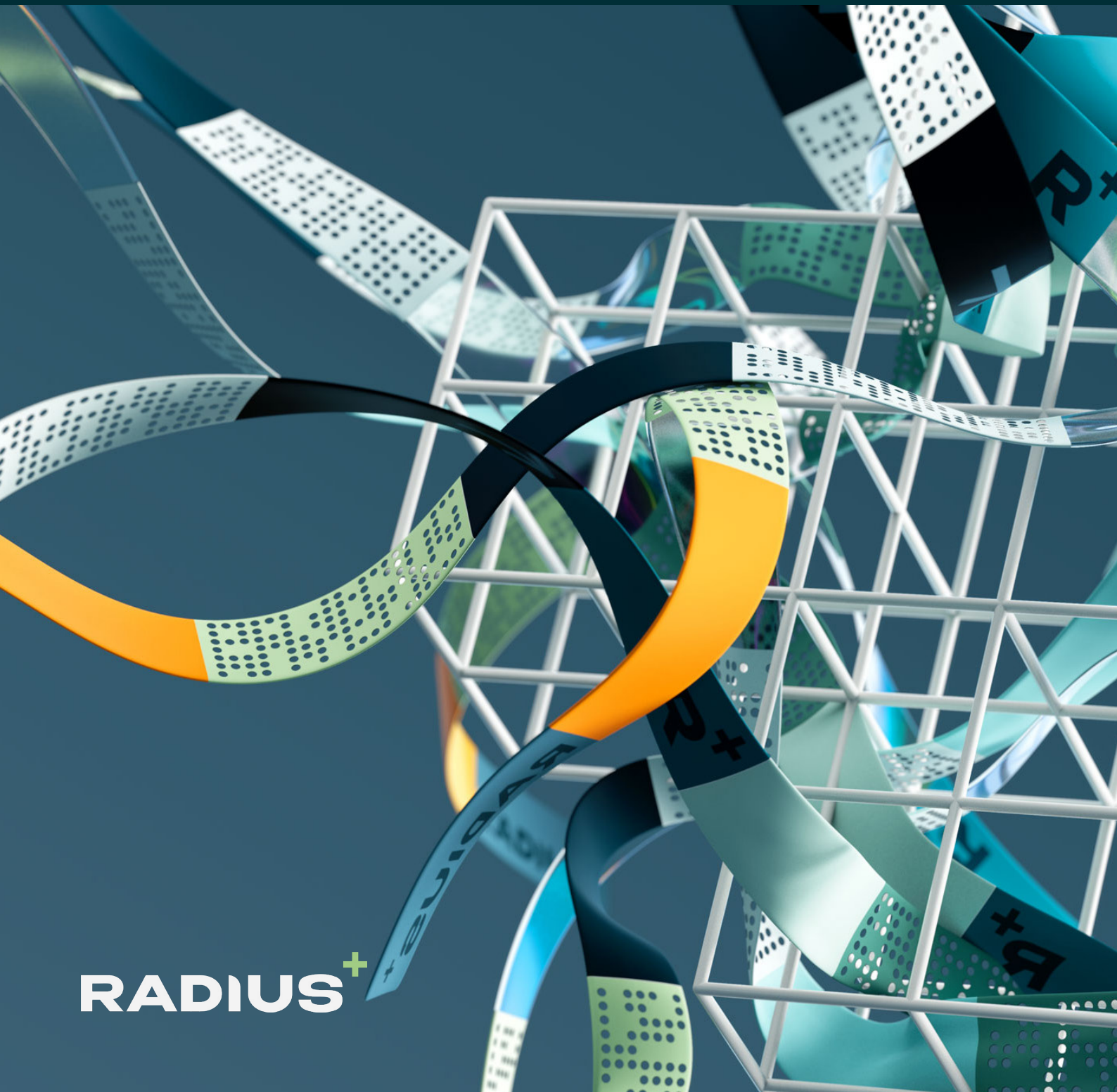

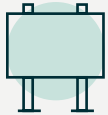
Higher traffic counts = higher visibility!

The question is: How do I take advantage of these new eyeballs? Some fairly easy solutions are as follows:



Neon Signs

Ensure you have the appropriate zoning approvals. Neon signs are bright and can be seen from a distance, especially at night.



Billboards

Place billboards strategically along the highway or major road leading to your facility. This can include directions and distance to your location.



Large Flags

A large American flag or a flag with your company's logo can catch the attention of drivers. The movement of the flag naturally draws the eye.



New Coat of Paint

Try to use bright colors, or if you can get away with it, try a mural that defines your community. Birds, Stars and Stripes

By combining these strategies, you can maximize the advantages of being near a high-traffic road and attract more customers to your self-storage facility.
